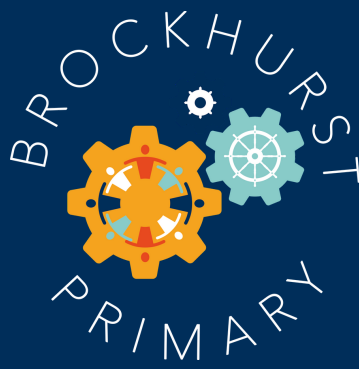

Thursday 5th May 2022 (Polling day)

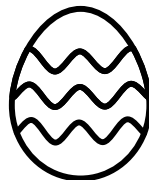

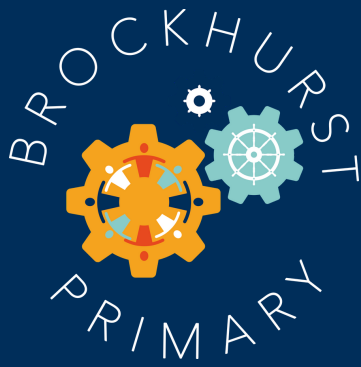

Although we are getting some sense of normality back, it is important that we stay vigilant.

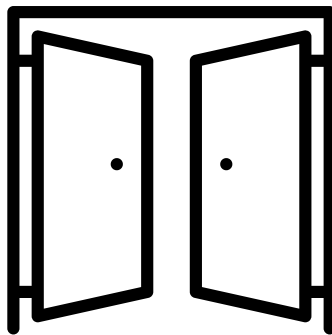
School gates will not be open before 8.30am and 3.05pm.

If you need to come into school you can make an appointment via phone or email.

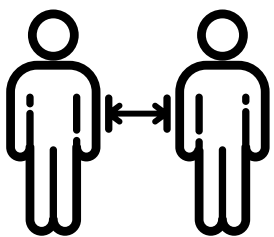


Please Wait Outside

It's really important that children and staff have a clear route in and out of the building to maintain social distancing.

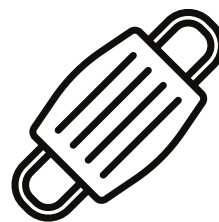

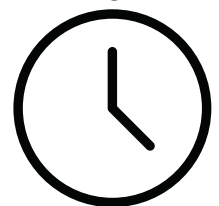
Keeping 2m Distance
