Dear Parents/Carers,

After Christmas, Year 6 will be studying Crime and Punishment with the key text driver being The Executioner's Daughter. To help them to get the best of out of the topic, we have been successful in securing free tickets for a visit to the Tower of London; we are very excited to be able to give our children this opportunity! They will get to tour the setting and to take part in a Crime and Punishment workshop.

This trip will take place on **Tuesday 27th February 2024**. As we will be travelling to London, we will need to set off promptly at 7:30am. We will therefore need children to be in school between **7:00-7:15am** to ensure we have enough time to register everyone.

We are expecting a late arrival back at school and anticipate that this will be around **6pm**, however, we cannot predict what the traffic will be like so we will make sure that we keep you updated on the day with a more accurate arrival time. Please do not call the office, they will contact you either by text message or class dojo. Please ensure your contact details are up to date with the office prior to the trip.

Children will need to wear full school uniform and comfortable shoes (trainers will be allowed) to walk around in. They will also need to be prepared for the weather (i.e., a warm, waterproof coat) as a lot of the tour will be outside. A packed lunch will be required with enough drinks to last for the whole day. If your child is entitled to free school meals, then a lunch can be ordered in advance and supplied. We also recommend that your child brings extra snacks for the afternoon/evening due to their late arrival home.

Although we have managed to secure free tickets for the Tower of London, we will need to pay for the coach. We have also managed to secure £300 funding towards the travel costs to keep the overall payment as low as possible. Therefore, a contribution of **£18.83** will be requested. We would like to advise that whilst this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not get enough payments, we will have to cancel the trip as the school is not in a financial position to be able to subsidise the trip. Please ensure this is paid by **31st January 2024**.
